Objective

To acquire through reflecting on the past experiences of our citizens who emigrated abroad, their difficult paths to integration and the rights they were denied, a greater awareness of our society which, nowadays, is a point of confluence for a variety of migrant populations and their diverse cultures, and these are transforming our social and cultural lives.

Form

A reflection on the theme of multi-culturalism, as well as on the racism and xenophobia experienced by Italian immigrants abroad. Through the examination of documents and images, pupils will gain an understanding of how prejudices against "foreigners" come into being and the consequences they have.
