THE MAGICAL PLANTS

Target Age Group

Primary School (4th and 5th years), Middle School and
Secondary School.

Objective

The in-depth study workshop aims at familiarising the participants with the plants which have been in most common use from ancient times to the present day. In the course of a guided walk through the grounds of the Rocca Flea numerous varieties will be examined. Once the pupils have seen the video, they will be given the opportunity to discuss, under the teachers' guidance, which plants and herbs they use in their daily lives and for what purposes.

Form

The guided tour will give participants the opportunity of admiring the publications by Castor Durante da Gualdo, the Herbario Novo (New Herbarium) and the Tesoro della Sanità (A Treasure of Health) and of taking part in an authentic field-study activity aimed at recognising and classifying some of the commonest wild and edible plants, whose value consists, not in their rarity, but in their being able to be recognised, appreciated and eaten.
