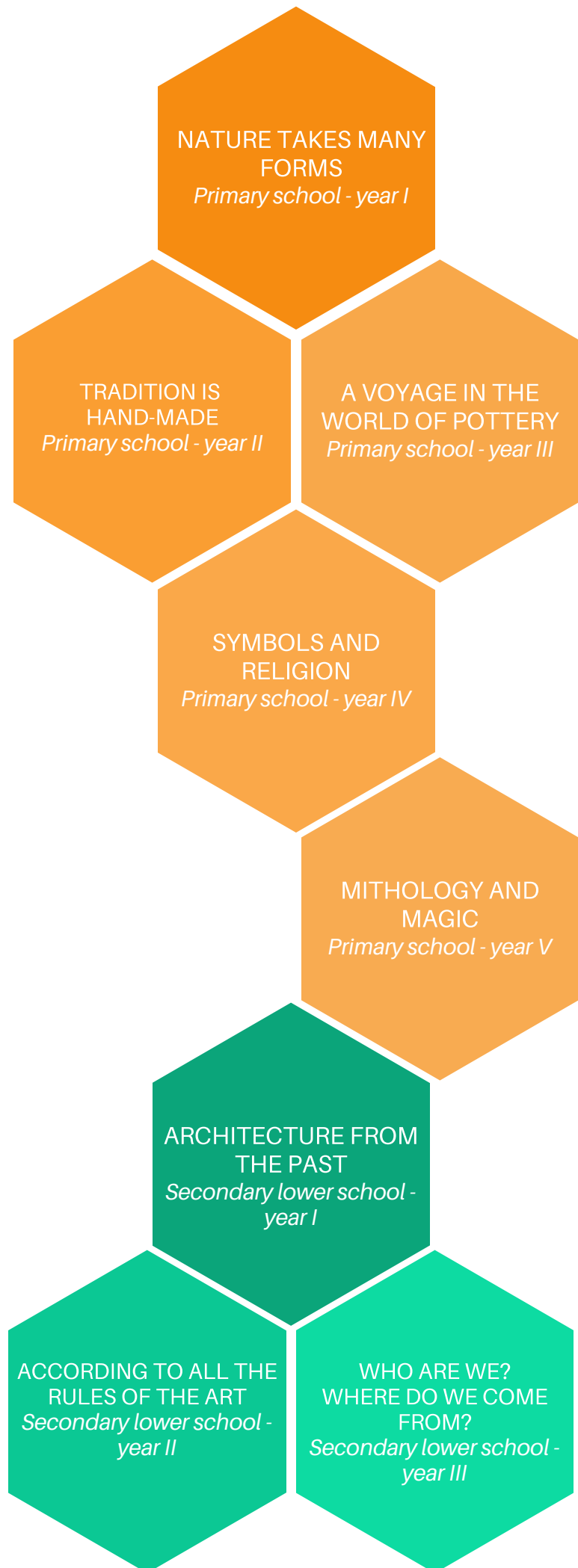


An educational tour in north est Umbria
